A regular service and maintenance routine for emergency safety showers and eye/face washes is essential to ensure this life-saving equipment operates effectively first time, every time.

If equipment fails to function correctly or further injures an employee then significant fines, or even imprisonment, are enforceable.

#### **Compliance & Auditing**

European and International standards (namely, EN15154 and ANSI/ISEA Z358.1-2014) recommend performance requirements for industrial eye wash units and safety showers. An in-depth annual inspection is necessary to achieve compliance to these standards.

As the manufacturer, Hughes recommend equipment be serviced and cleaned regularly, at least every 6 months.

#### Bacteria Control

By their very nature, safety showers and eye washes possess traits that pose a risk of harmful bacteria growth. Weekly activations are recommended to flush pipes of any sediment build up and minimize the chance of stagnant water.

A regular service goes one step further—all essential parts are cleaned and disinfected, and tank showers are emptied and chlorinated.

#### Warranty Requirements

Your safety showers and eye washes must be used, maintained and installed according to the instructions and procedures for the warranty to be effective. ## >> Extend your warranty with installation and commissioning by Hughes

When you purchase new safety showers or eye washes, ensure they operate as intended by enlisting Hughes to install and commission your equipment in accordance with local legislation and compliance to industry standards. Plus, you'll receive an additional 12 months warranty!

- Equipment will be mounted to a suitable surface, as per the general arrangement drawings and the stability checked.
- ☑ The area will be assessed to ensure there are no obstructions, the unit is clearly visible and compliant safety signage is displayed.
- ☑ Once assembled, all filters will be removed and pipework flushed prior to connection to clear any installation debris.
- For equipment with electrical heating, the thermostat operation and setting will be verified to ensure the correct water temperature is reached.
- Optional fittings, such as alarms and beacons, will be fully installed.
- Confirm proper operation, such as flow rate and control valve operation in line with European standards.

### Smart monitoring of your assets

Build a foundation of safety with Hughes Connect, a monitoring system offering 24/7 tracking of your emergency safety showers and eye/face wash equipment.

A dashboard reporting tool, developed in partnership with Microsoft<sup>®</sup>, provides data on water supply temperature, ambient temperatures and tank shower water levels, plus instant alerts if maintenance is required or if a unit has been activated. Weekly activations, required by both EN15154 and ANSI Z358.1-2014 standards, can also be tracked. All data and tracking information is stored on the Cloud for instant access from anywhere at anytime.



Hughes Connect is a subscription based service and can be added to either our Essential or Essential *Plus* service contracts. Costs are determined based on your unique site requirements.


## How does it work?

Sensors are fitted to the equipment to monitor shower and/ or eye wash activation, tank levels and water temperature.

Encrypted messages are sent from the sensors to a central gateway(s) providing live metrics on the status and performance of the showers and/or eye washes. The gateway must be connected to the internet either via Wi-Fi or a LAN connection - these speak securely to the Hughes cloud based system storing the information safely.

Alerts are sent when the water temperature is out of the recommended range, the water level is low or when an activation takes place. Utilising a low power, long distance protocol enables the sensors to communicate across expansive sites.
